PARADE RULES

1. Parade starts at 10:00 a.m. SHARP. Units not in position will be placed in the last division.
2. FORWARD MOTION: A continuously forward moving parade from start to finish. NO stopping allowed in judges' area.
3. The American Legion Competitive Flag Code will apply to all mounted entries.
4. The California State Horsemen's Association rules apply to all mounted entries.
5. Horses will be prejudged at 8:00 a.m., 2 blocks south of Robertson Blvd at Orange Ave and Tenth Street.
6. **Floats:**
Professional - Built by commercial companies.
Amateur- Built by free labor with own design.
Commercial- Advertising a product.
Minis- Maximum size 10 ft. by 6 ft.
7. Float entries must remain in the same category as originally entered throughout the parade season.
8. NO entry may enter the parade route more than one time for competition, regardless of change in name or appearance.
9. Entries involving vehicles or animals must maintain control of them. **NO ONE** under six (6) years of age may appear as an entry unless accompanied by an adult.
10. The judging stand shall be located on the right side of the line of march between Third and Fourth Streets.
11. The competition area will consist of 100 feet, clearly marked with white lines and/or signs for a distance of 50 feet in each direction from the center of the judging area.
12. An information table will be provided at the corner of Eleventh Street and Robertson Boulevard.
13. Entrants must complete the entire parade route or be disqualified.
14. Units with sound or unusual noise must so indicate on the entry form. Failure to do so will result in being penalized/disqualified.
15. For safety reasons, there will be **NO** throwing of objects into the spectator area. Failure to comply may result in being disqualified.
16. Parade Awards will be presented at the Little Theater at the Chowchilla Fairgrounds at **3:30 p.m.** Those not present may pick up their awards at the Fair Office within the next 30 days. Cash awards will be mailed.
17. Only participants in the parade will be permitted free admission into the Fairgrounds. A parking area will be next to the Fairgrounds on Third Street for parade participants only.
18. Band, Marching & Float Entrants who would like a score sheet - come to the Parade Office after all awards are given out. PLEASE only one person representing each entry. Score sheets with multiple entries will be in the office window for viewing and not passed out. Horse entries: Contact Horse Judge. If by mail, present a stamped, self-addressed envelope at the Parade Office or write Chowchilla Spring Festival, PO Box 457, Chowchilla, CA 93610. Please give class number and name of unit. Allow 30 days for return.
