

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

CITY OF GONZALES GONZALES, TEXAS 2020 STREET IMPROVEMENT PLANS

Separate sealed bids addressed to the City of Gonzales (OWNER) clearly labeled “**ATTENTION: CITY SECRETARY, 2020 STREET IMPROVEMENT PLANS**” will be received at Gonzales City Hall, 820 St. N. Joseph Street, Gonzales, Texas 78629, until **2:00 o’clock p.m. on Thursday, February 20, 2020**, and then publicly opened and read aloud immediately.

This project includes the reconstruction of approximately 1200 linear feet of street (Larry Drive) including reclaiming and cement stabilization of existing pavement, installation of limestone base, installation of curb & gutter, installation of a two-course surface treatment for pavement, and installation of a new curb inlet and storm sewer for drainage.

The project also includes reconstruction of approximately 4800 linear feet of Independence Park Road including reclaiming and cement stabilization of existing pavement and installation of a 2-course surface treatment. In addition, alternate bids for reclaiming and resurfacing additional roads within Independence Park will also be considered.

The Contract Documents, consisting of Advertisement for Bids, Information for Bidders, Bid Proposal, Bid Bond, Agreement, Performance and Payment Bonds, General Conditions, Special Conditions, Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, Technical Specifications and Plans, together with any Addenda are available at Doucet & Associates, Inc., 829 N. Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents may be examined and purchased for a non-refundable fee of \$50.00, or can be provided via e-mail at no charge.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a cashier’s check or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total actual bid price payable without recourse to the City of Gonzales, or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into a contract and execute required performance and payment bonds.

The contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder; however, the right is reserved, as the interests of the OWNER may require, to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informality or minor defects in bids received. Bids may be held by the OWNER for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of the opening for Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.

There will not be a pre-bid conference. Contractors shall make their own individual site inspections and/or investigations to make themselves aware of existing conditions/issues. Failure to make adequate observations, investigations and/or ask questions prior to bidding shall not be grounds for requesting additional work or services. Questions shall be forwarded to J.
