here are 5 low income housing apartment complexes which contain 276 affordable apartments for rent in Gonzales. These complexes are funded through TDHCA issued tax credits. In Gonzales, HUD housing programs support 90 rental assistance apartments through programs like Project-based Section 8.

Describe the applicant's past efforts to increase the supply of affordable housing.

The City of Gonzales recognizes the need for affordable housing and has supported previous developer applications for tax credits.

Describe any future efforts that the applicant plans to undertake to increase the supply of affordable housing.

Future efforts to increase the supply and condition of affordable housing include the contracting of a grant administrator to apply for affordable housing funds for rehabilitation and new construction through TDHCA.

Describe any instances where the applicant has applied for affordable housing funds and did not receive the funding.

The City has not applied for affordable housing funds within the last five years and has supported all efforts to build and maintain affordable housing.

Describe any instances, within the past five years, where the applicant has not accepted funds for affordable housing.

he applicant has supported all efforts at developing affordable housing in the last five years. There are no instances where affordable housing funds have been offered and not accepted.

Describe the applicant's efforts, within the past three years, to provide infrastructure improvements through the issuance of general obligation or revenue bonds.

The City of Gonzales applied for and received \$852,300 in CDBG-DR funds through the General Land Office, with an additional \$69,756 in General Funds provided to replace wastewater infrastructure benefiting LMI residents. The City of Gonzales also issued a Combination Tax and Surplus Electric System Revenue Certificate of Obligation, Series 2017 in the amount of \$1,635,000 for repairs to Hydroelectric plant. The City issued a Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 2019 for constructing street and drainage improvements at various locations in the City, acquiring and constructing improvements to the City's system and acquiring and installing new water meters in various areas of the City in the amount of \$5,660,000.

Census-based information was used to document the LMI beneficiaries the application activity. Beneficiaries of the project were identified through the most recent LMISD information. City staff reviewed several possible projects and found the replacement of existing and new ADA accessible sidewalks, along with the drainage improvements, associated with the sidewalk replacement and lighting improvements, to be the most of the most impact and cost effective for the community. One of the top goals of the City of Gonzales' Comprehensive Plan in late 2015 was to restore downtown vitality. The needs addressed in this application are a key to downtown improvement. The existing sidewalks along St. James Street are unsafe and mostly impassible. Creating 6' ADA accessible sidewalks along St. James Street, along with associated drainage improvements and curb cuts will make Main Street safe, attractive and accessible for all residents.

Texas Heroes Square is located at the intersection of N. St Joseph Street and St. Lawrence Street. The square honors the residents of Gonzales that answered the call for help from those at the Alamo and fought in the Texas Revolution. The monument (by sculptor Pompeo Coppini) was built in 1910. The City of Gonzales has seven public squares in the center of town and has maintained the plan of the town as originally surveyed. The one in the center of downtown, where the other sidewalk improvements will be made, was originally planned for a municipal building but became the Plaza, now called Texas Heroes Square.

This project is a key first step to Gonzales rebuilding its city center, bringing it back to a thriving main street with shared parking, a marketplace, retail and restaurants. Reinvestment in the older parts of the city stabilizes neighborhoods and creates quality locations for younger residents seeking homeownership opportunities. As the downtown area becomes revitalized, the connections to adjacent neighborhoods are strengthened, and people can walk or bike from home to downtown.

This project was submitted to and approved by City Council on August 13, 2020. This project will not disproportionately affect or impact vulnerable populations. The property is already owned by the City of Gonzales.
