Former President George H. W. Bush’s funeral procession will pass through Navasota on December 6, 2018.

The funeral procession is set to leave Spring, TX at 1 p.m. and arrive in College Station, TX at 3:25 p.m.

Law enforcement officers will be present along the railroad tracks to ensure safety of all spectators. Navasota Police Department requests that spectators stay at least 25 feet from the railroad tracks and respect the barriers in place. To ensure safety, spectators will not be allowed to cross the barriers in place.

According to Texas Penal Code 28.07, it is a violation to enter or remain on railroad property. Citizens may cross tracks at designated crossings.

The City of Navasota is encouraging spectators to watch the procession on either side of the train tracks between Washington Ave. and Johnson St.

Roads will be blocked for vehicular traffic at N. Railroad St. from E. Dickson to Stoneham St. and S. Railroad St. from Washington Ave. to Johnson St. to provide safety to all.
