



The Navasota Police Department has recently had two vehicles reported stolen this week. Both vehicles were left unlocked with the keys inside of the vehicle.

The vehicle stolen from Boulder St. was recovered by the Navasota PD shortly after being reported stolen yesterday.

- Engrave your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or personal I.D. number on expensive accessories and parts
