

## Annual City Cleanup Week

The City of Navasota Sanitation Department conducts an Annual City Cleanup Week for City of Navasota residents in early spring. The goal of this successful program is to provide a way for all citizens to dispose of unwanted junk and debris at no cost, clean properties, and beautify our city. During this event, residents can bring their unwanted junk and debris items to the City of Navasota Vehicle Services Center Drop Off Site located at 520 Malcolm Street.

The following items are accepted at no charge. Verification of City residency is required.

- Wood and lumber.
- Metal, steel, tin, cast iron and scrap metal items.
- Automotive Batteries
- Large bulky items such as stoves, bedsprings, mattresses, couches and refrigerators (appliances that may contain freon, must have a certificate of freon removal from an appliance technician before it will be accepted).
- Used Motor Oil and oil filters will be accepted up to 5 gallons from Do-It-Yourselfers. No commercial quantities.

### Items that are NOT Accepted

- Household Garbage – No household garbage. It will be collected on your normal collection days.
- Tires
- Intangible Waste
- Paints and varnishes
- Paint removers
- Nail polish removers
- Gasoline and kerosene
- Adhesive glues
- Air fresheners
- Corrosive Waste (Acids & Caustics)
- Poisons
- Ant and roach disinfectants
- Fungicides
- Flea spray or powder
- Moth crystals
- Weed and grass killer
- Windshield wiper fluid
- Cleaning Solutions
- Floor polishes
- Wood polishes
- Wood cleaners

These items will not be accepted at the City Cleanup Drop Off Site. You may however store your items in a safe, dry place so that you may take them to the next Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event. These events are conducted in the spring and fall months.
