## **ENTRY INFORMATION:**

1. **Parking will be at the back of the Clay County Extension Office.**
2. Each exhibitor and 1 parent will receive one (1) entry ticket per person. **Extra tickets will need to be purchased prior to April 1.**
3. Contest will be held in UF/IFAS Extension Clay County classroom.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. 4-H Horticulture Judging standards and guidelines will be followed in this contest.
2. A judging team shall consist of three (3) or four (4) bonafide 4-H Club or FFA members. Only the scores of the three (3) highest members will be considered in awarding team prizes.

3. Each county may enter four (4) 4-H teams per club and each FFA Chapter may enter four (4) teams. Additional teams and individuals are welcome to participate for practice. Individuals are eligible for individual awards.
4. 4-H or FFA members must meet the following criteria in order to participate:
  - (a) JUNIOR DIVISION: Any 4-H'er who reaches their 8th birthday by September 1st of the current 4-H year and has not passed their 11th birthday by September 1st of the current 4-H year.
  - (c) INTERMEDIATE DIVISION: Any 4-H'er who reaches their 11th birthday by September 1st of the current 4-H year and has not passed their 14th birthday by September 1st of the current 4-H year. FFA Chapters from Junior High or Middle Schools.
  - (b) SENIOR DIVISION: Any 4-H'er who reaches their 14th birthday prior to September 1st of the current 4-H year and has not passed their 19th birthday or graduated from high school prior to September 1st of the current 4-H year is a senior division participant. FFA High School Students (including 9<sup>th</sup> grade).
5. Classes to be judged will be Identification of Ornamental Plants, Vegetables, Fruits and Nuts, and Flowers and Foliage.
6. Awards: FFA and 4-H are judged separately.
7. Participants with special needs, including food allergies, will need to designate on Entry Form.

3. 4-H Junior Division
4. 4-H Intermediate Division
5. 4-H Senior Division
