COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Terms and Conditions, General Livestock Competition Requirements, and Health Requirements. When applicable all association rules shall apply.
2. All entrants for livestock exhibited in Open, Breed, or Market competitions shall provide a premises identification number at the time of entry.
3. **BEDDING:** Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the Colorado State Fair and Industrial Exposition does not include bedding. Bedding may be pre-purchased on Livestock Entry forms and must be received in the Livestock Office with payment by entry deadline. Pre-purchased bedding may be picked up in the designated area on load-in days. Exhibitors must be present to claim their pre-purchased bedding. Refunds will not be issued for any pre-purchased bedding.

Straw may only be used for Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Breeding Sheep and Cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.

4. Copies of registration papers must be submitted with entries. Original registration papers must be available for inspection at the show.
5. The American Hereford Association offers 10% of the total premiums including champion classes. The Colorado State Fair will pay 90% of the total premiums including champion classes. Premium checks for the full amount will be paid directly from the Colorado State Fair.
6. All animals entered in this combined Hereford/Polled Hereford show must be registered with the American Hereford Association or the American Polled Hereford Association to be eligible to show. Animals must be entered and shown under the recorded owner's name.
7. Any animal without a legible tattoo matching the registration papers will be ineligible to show.
8. Exhibitors in these breeding cattle classes are subject to their association's special rules on class qualification, defects and unethical practices. All animals at all AHA sponsored shows must be officially recorded at show time to be eligible to show. An official AHA registry number at entry time will be required.

9. All Hereford entries must be duly recorded with the American Hereford Association. Any animal with a "pending" or "applied for" registration or without a legible tattoo will not be eligible for show competition. All entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the American Hereford Association Board of Directors, and are subject to supervision of the Show and Sale Committee representing the AHA.
10. Scurs on polled Herefords should be left as is and should not be tampered with or removed.
11. Colorado State Fair Officials have the right to combine any class with 5 or less animals.
12. Calf entries from Cow/Calf cannot be older than 270 days on show date. Calf is eligible for individual classes but must be entered in appropriate class. **Cow/calf does not compete for overall champion female.**
13. In the Cow/Calf class, if the cow is horned and the calf polled, then the pair will show in the horned Cow/Calf class and if the cow is polled and the calf is horned, then the pair will show in the polled Cow/Calf class.
14. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this show or in any one of these classes. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR - Exhibitor is defined as the owner or owners of an animal recorded on the registration paper. Each different recorded ownership (or co-ownership) constitutes a different "Exhibitor". An award will be given to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on six animals or less. In the event of tie, the winner will be the exhibitor (1) earning points in the greatest number of classes excluding champion classes, (2) winning the most first places and (3) winning the most second places, etc.

Points will be awarded as follows, unless otherwise stated under individual breed:

1 st place – 5 points	Champion – 7 points
2 nd place – 4 points	Reserve Champion – 6 points
3 rd place – 3 points	Grand Champion – 10 points
4 th place – 2 points	Reserve Grand Champion – 8 points
5 th place – 1 point
