COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Terms and Conditions, General Livestock Competition Requirements, and Health Requirements. When applicable all association rules shall apply.
2. All entrants for livestock exhibited in Open, Breed, or Market competitions shall provide a premises identification number at the time of entry.
3. **BEDDING:** Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the Colorado State Fair and Industrial Exposition does not include bedding. Bedding may be pre-purchased on Livestock Entry forms and must be received in the Livestock Office with payment by entry deadline. Pre-purchased bedding may be picked up in the designated area on load-in days. Exhibitors must be present to claim their pre-purchased bedding. Refunds will not be issued for any pre-purchased bedding.

Straw may only be used for Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Breeding Sheep and Cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.

4. Open Maine-Anjou heifers will be $\frac{3}{4}$ to Purebred. MaineTainer heifers are $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{5}{8}$. Open Maine-Anjou bulls will be $\frac{3}{4}$ to Purebred. MaineTainer bulls are $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{5}{8}$.
5. Copies of registration papers must be provided at the time of entry. Original registration papers must be available for inspection at the show.
6. The Rocky Mountain Maine-Anjou Association, President Brian Fox, 3584 County Road 22, Fort Morgan, CO 970-313-7224, offers 25% of the total premiums including champion classes. The Colorado State Fair will pay 75% of the total premiums including champion classes. The combined premiums listed below are paid directly by the Colorado State Fair.
7. Membership fees with the Rocky Mountain Maine-Anjou Association must be paid prior to participation in the Open Maine-Anjou Show. The annual membership fee shall be \$50.00 per individual with a maximum fee of \$100.00 per family. A family is defined as parent/guardian and any immediate minor under their care, through the age of twenty-one (21) as of December 31st of that year. The annual dues shall follow the calendar year.

8. The surgical or non-surgical alteration of conformation of an animal, except dehorning, is prohibited. The use of false tailheads or the addition of hair or other material to any part of the body or the use of any dyes or artificial coloring agents on any part of the body above the flanks is prohibited. All animals over 7 months of age must be dehorned.
9. Calf entries from the Cow-Calf Pair Class can show individually, providing individual entry is made. Calves must be halter broke and shown at halter. Cows may be evaluated and screened out of the show based on udder quality. The determination of the officials will be final.
10. All females 20 months of age or older must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy. A certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must accompany heifers used in embryo transfer.
11. All bulls over 14 months of age must have a certificate indicating positive semen test.
12. Colorado State Fair Officials have the right to combine any class with 5 or less animals.

14. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this show or in any one of these classes. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR - Exhibitor is defined as the owner or owners of an animal recorded on the registration paper. Each different recorded ownership (or co-ownership) constitutes a different "Exhibitor". An award will be given to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on six animals or less. In the event of tie, the winner will be the exhibitor (1) earning points in the greatest number of classes excluding champion classes, (2) winning the most first places and (3) winning the most second places, etc.

Points will be awarded as follows, unless otherwise stated under individual breed:

- 1st place – 5 points
- 2nd place – 4 points
- 3rd place – 3 points
- 4th place – 2 points
- 5th place – 1 point

- Champion – 7 points
- Reserve Champion – 6 points
- Grand Champion – 10 points
- Reserve Grand Champion – 8 points
