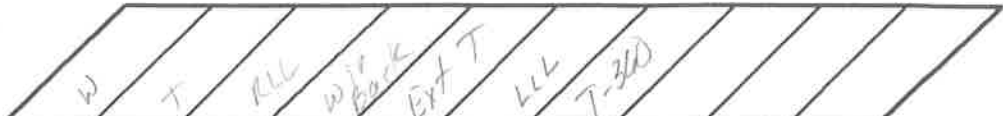

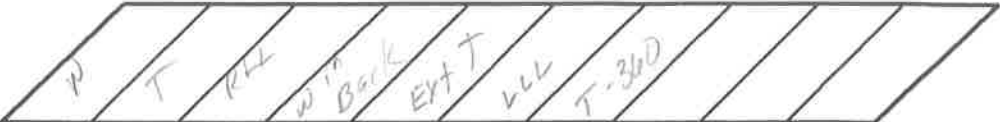

- B. Out of lead or break of gait at lope (except when correcting an incorrect lead)
- C. Knocking down an elevated pole, cone, barrel or plant obstacle, or severely disturbing an obstacle
- E. Stepping outside the confines, falling or jumping off or out of obstacle with 1 foot
- F. Missing or evading a pole in a series of obstacles with one foot
- G. Horse moves more than 2 steps on ground tie

10 POINT PENALTY

After three refusals at a single obstacle or when deemed necessary by the judge, the judge will ask the contestant to proceed to the next obstacle. This penalty is in addition to any penalties accrued at the obstacle.

5 POINT PENALTIES

- A. Dropping slicker or object required to be carried on course
- B. Use of either hand to instill fear or praise
- C. Stepping outside of the confines of, falling, or jumping off of or out of an obstacle with more than one foot
- D. Holding saddle with either hand
- E. Blatant disobedience (kicking out, bucking, rearing, striking)
- F. Horse misses/evades an element/component of an obstacle in a series with more than one foot
- G. Each refusal. Refusals are cumulative up to a total of 15 penalty points - includes balking, evading, shying, running past or backing more than 2 strides; complete loss of gate (note, in the case of a rope gate, if the rope is dropped, the rider must continue on and will be assessed a 15 point penalty); unwillingness to approach, negotiate or complete an obstacle.

0 SCORE - Should not be placed above any horse which receives a score

- A. Use of more than one finger between split reins
- B. Use of two hands (exception, junior horses ridden in a snaffle or hackamore or when changing hands to work an obstacle)
- C. Use of romal other than as outlined.
- D. Skipping or no attempt to perform an obstacle
- E. Performing an obstacle incorrectly, or other than in the specified order
- F. Failure to enter, exit or work an obstacle from correct side or direction, including overturns more than ¼ turn
- G. Failure to work an obstacle in any manner, other than how posted
- H. Equipment failure that delays completion of pattern
- I. Fall to ground by horse or rider
- J. Excessive schooling
- K. Failure to ever demonstrate the correct lead and/or gait as designated
