How You Can Help

- Receiving (in-take of entries) and judging days for Fine Arts, Beer, Needle Arts, Quilts, Arts and Crafts, Amateur Art, Dolls, and Pantry.
- Depending on the needs of Department Coordinators, help setting up displays might be needed.
- When the fair ends, helpers are needed to release exhibits to exhibitors (September 6th).

Expectations of a Volunteer

- Please make a commitment to report to volunteer on time and be ready to work. Make note of scheduled shifts, as we will not be able to call to confirm your times.
- Be willing to accept the guidance and decisions of Department Coordinators.
- Carry out duties in an efficient and reliable manner.
- Maintain the dignity and integrity of Colorado State Fair with the people you work with and exhibitors.
- Honor confidential information.
- Please do not talk to the press.

Be Sure To

- Wear comfortable clothes and shoes.
- Check in and check out so we know how many hours you work.
- Bring a lunch and snacks (refrigerator available) on days food will not be served. Iced tea and water will be provided every day. Lunch will be provided every Saturday (July 29th-August 19th) for volunteers who are working, as well as Pantry judging day and Release Day.

Why Volunteer

- Colorado State Fair helps to preserve the rich history of our culture and provide a place for all to participate in prestigious competitions for the arts, skills, and crafts they love. You can be a part of this process and connect with great people.
- Volunteering is a great way to learn about those arts, skills, and crafts people love to do and how the judging process works.
- You will receive a single-day gate admission pass for every four hours you give your time. An 11-day gate admission wristband will be awarded to the volunteer who dedicates the most time volunteering by August 24th.
