Schedule

(Receiving, judging, and release will be located in the Fine Arts Gallery.)

Entry form and fee deadline — Friday, July 19, 2019, by 4:00 p.m.

Receiving — Saturday, July 27, 2019, 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Judging — Tuesday, July 30, 2019 (closed to the public)

Reception — Thursday, August 22, 2019, 5:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.(open to the public)

Release — Artwork that is not accepted must be picked up before **Sunday, August 11, 2019**. Gallery hours will be posted when results are posted on **August 2, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.**. Accepted artwork, and any not accepted artwork remaining, will be released on **Wednesday, September 4, 2019, 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. at the Fine Arts Gallery.**

Competition and Entry Requirements (these rules and requirements are **in addition** to *2019 General Competition Requirements* as well as *GE/FA 2019 Competition & Entry Requirements*)

Eligibility

1. Open to all living residents of Colorado.
2. Original artwork only. No seminar pieces may be entered.
3. Artwork must have been completed within the last two years.
4. Artwork may not have been previously exhibited at Colorado State Fair.

Presentation Requirements

1. All artwork must be unwrapped and installation-ready.
2. Two-dimensional artwork must be suitably-framed (i.e. no poster frames) and wired using strong screw eyes and wire.
3. Artwork with clip mounts, missing wires, string, scotch tape, or sawtooth hangers will not be accepted.
4. All artwork must be dry when submitted for the exhibition.

5. Completed identification labels must be firmly attached to the back, upper left-hand corner of all two-dimensional works or the bottom of all three-dimensional works. (Labels can be found online or with entry form.)
6. Due to limited space, we discourage entries over 5x5x5 feet.
7. The Fine Arts Director will have the final decision regarding proper artwork condition and location of each piece.

Fees

1. Maximum of five pieces (entries) per artist.
2. Entry form and a non-refundable fee of \$11.00 for Emerging Artist Division is required for each piece (entry).
3. Entry form and a non-refundable fee of \$15.00 for Professional Division is required for each piece (entry).
4. Artists may purchase 11-day Colorado State Fair wristbands at \$35.00 each. These purchases and payments should be included in your grand total when you submit your entry form.

Payment Methods

Payments can be made by cash, check, or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express). Make checks payable to Colorado State Fair. Returned checks will be assessed a \$35.00 service fee.

Selection Process

1. This is a *juried* competition. All artwork is juried, and only the works accepted by the jurors will be displayed in the Fine Arts Gallery during the Colorado State Fair, August 23 — September 2, 2019.
2. The jurors have sole responsibility for the selection of artwork to be exhibited and awarded under their authority.
3. The jurors' decisions are final.
4. The jury process is closed and confidential.
5. Award-winning artwork will be photographed for catalog, internet, and publicity purposes.

Notification of Accepted/Not Accepted Artwork

Notification of "Accepted" and "Not Accepted" artwork will be posted on the Colorado State Fair website (coloradostatefair.com) at 5:00 pm, Friday, August 2, 2019. **Please do not call us prior to this time as we are working to get those results posted as quickly as possible. No results will be given out early.** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to make sure the General Entry Office has the correct and current address for the exhibitor so that award checks can be mailed, accordingly.

Release of Not Accepted Artwork

1. Not Accepted artwork must be picked up before Sunday, August 11, 2019. Pick up hours will be posted when results are posted on August 2, 2019.
2. If you do not pick up your artwork by that date, artwork will be stored until the completion of the Fine Arts Exhibition and will be released to you on Wednesday, September 4, 2019, 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. at the Fine Arts Gallery, Colorado State Fair.
3. Artwork not claimed on this day becomes the property of the Colorado State Fair unless prior arrangements are made.

Release of Accepted Artwork

1. Accepted artwork must be exhibited the 11 days of the Fine Arts Exhibition and the Colorado State Fair, August 23 — September 2. No exceptions!
2. Exhibition artwork will be released on Wednesday, September 4, 2019, 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. at the Fine Arts Gallery, Colorado State Fair.
3. Artwork not claimed on this day becomes the property of the Colorado State Fair unless prior arrangements are made.

Sale of Artwork

1. Colorado State Fair will retain a 25% commission on all art sales.
2. The sale price of the artwork must be clearly indicated on the entry form. Not for sale artwork must be identified "NFS."
3. Artists who sell artwork are required to complete a W-9 Form.

Entry Procedures

Artwork can be submitted three ways—electronically, mailed, or hand-delivered. Exhibitors must pre-register (complete entry form and pay fees) online or at the General Entry Office in the Palace of Agriculture beginning Monday, June 3 and continuing through Friday, July 19, 2019.

Electronically-submitted Artwork

Due Friday, July 19, 2019

- Electronically-submitted artwork is optional. Please only submit your work electronically if you do not plan to hand deliver your work for judging.
- When registering online, you will be prompted to upload images of artwork after registration process.
- Electronically-submitted pieces that are accepted must arrive at the Colorado State Fair ready to hang or display by close of posted hours on Sunday, August 11, 2019.

Mail-submitted Artwork

Due Friday, July 19, 2019

- We accept mailed artwork. Completed identification labels must be firmly attached to the back, upper-left hand corner of all two-dimensional works or the bottom of all three-dimensional works. (Labels can be found online or with entry form.)
- Calculate any state fair 11-day wristband purchases and the total non-refundable entry fee and include amount owed with the entry form. All artwork must be mailed, prepaid. Mail artwork, entry form, and fees to:

Hand-delivered Artwork 2019

Entry form and fees due Friday, July 19th,

Artwork must be dropped-off on Saturday, July 27, 2019 by 3:00PM

- All entry forms and fees (online, mailed, and hand-delivered) must be received by Friday, July 19th. We will accept hand-delivered artwork on Saturday, July 27, 2019, 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. at the Fine Arts Gallery, Colorado State Fair. Enter the Fairgrounds through Gate #1 on Arroyo Avenue. All hand-delivered artwork will be received at the FRONT entrance to the Fine Arts Gallery.
- Print neatly so your name, titles of your artwork, and pricing are legible. Titles and prices on your entry form should match the label attached to your artwork.
- All items must have proper hardware, be fully unpacked and labeled prior to getting in receiving line. If your items are not ready for receiving, you will be sent back to unpacking table before being allowed to proceed.

Professional Division

Entry Fee — \$15.00 per piece

Criteria

Make sure you are completing the entry form for the Division that best suits you. You are a professional if a majority of the following applies to you:

1. You have a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Fine Arts, Masters or Doctorate in Art; or
2. A significant portion of your annual income is earned through the sale of your artwork; or
3. You have won numerous awards for your art in juried national or regional exhibitions; or
4. You currently, or in the past, have had exhibitions within a museum environment; or
5. You are a visual art instructor; or
6. You currently, or in the recent past, have had commercial gallery representation..

Criteria

Make sure you are completing the entry form for the Division that best suits you. You are an emerging artist if a majority of the following applies to you:

1. You are currently enrolled in high school or college; or
2. You regularly take art classes from professional instructors; or
3. You are not consistently showing your art within commercial galleries; or
4. You have not won numerous awards in national or regional juried exhibitions; or
5. Your income is not significantly impacted by the sale of your artwork; or
6. You enter fewer than six juried exhibitions annually.
