- We will not call to confirm your attendance.

As a fair Volunteer we ask that you:

- Be on time for scheduled duties.
- Accept the guidance and decisions of the coordinators.
- Carry out duties in a prompt and reliable manner.
- Maintain the dignity and integrity of the Colorado State Fair with the public.
- Maintain smooth working relationships and stay within the bounds of the volunteerism.
- Honor Confidential Information.
- **DO NOT TALK to the press-as this is the duty of the Fair Manager.**
- Act as a goodwill ambassador to the Fair.

When you come to Volunteer:

- Wear comfortable clothing and shoes. (No open toe shoes)
- Remember to check in and check out.
- Smoking inside buildings is prohibited (this includes vapor Cigarettes as well).

When you volunteer for a show you will receive a gate pass and parking pass for the time you volunteer.
