



WHAT'S NEW IN LIVESTOCK FOR 2019

PLEASE READ the Livestock Parking and Pass Information for specific information regarding parking information and exhibitor pass information. Trailer parking is now located at the intersection of Pueblo Boulevard and Lake Avenue. Please ask the front desk in the Livestock Office for directions. This is a secure 24-hour trailer only parking lot. No sleeping in trailers allowed in the parking lot.

BEDDING - Exhibitors will be allowed to bring in bedding (see specific rule in both General Livestock Competition Requirements and Junior Livestock Competition Requirements). Exhibitors may order bedding at the time of entry and pick up at time of arrival. A limited amount of additional bedding may be purchased from D&K Feed's location in the Horse Show area (they will not deliver).

Gate 4 will be opened at 5:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 21st for exhibitors to prepare stalls ahead of animals being unloaded. Animals will be checked at the health certificate checkpoint starting at 7:00 a.m. and allowed on grounds at that time.

The number of Market Goats eligible to be sold at the Junior Livestock Sale has been increased, the Colorado State Fair will now sell up to 38 Market Goats.

Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Junior Livestock Sale qualifiers will be showcased at the PRCA Rodeo on Monday, August 26th.

Temple Grandin will do a presentation on animal handling and welfare for Livestock Exhibitors at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 25th in the Colorado Building and at 7:00 p.m. in the Events Center – tickets required, all exhibitors can pick up tickets in Livestock Office.
