

SMALL ANIMAL PASS, PARKING AND ADMISSION INFORMATION

Special Gate and Parking Pass information for Livestock exhibitors! Passes should be purchased with Colorado State Fair Livestock Entries. No passes will be mailed out to exhibitors. Exhibitors can pick up their passes in the Livestock Office when they arrive and check in.

Beginning Friday, August 23rd, everyone who walks through Gate 2 **MUST** have either a wristband or general admission ticket. Daily tickets may be purchased at Gates #3 (Carnival Gate), #5 (Prairie Gate) and #9 (Beulah Gate). The Colorado State Fair will be offering Special Discount Days – those will be posted at coloradostatefair.com.

All Small Animal exhibitors will park in the section of the VIP lot and bring animals/birds in through Gate 2. After unloading animals/birds, Exhibitors should check in with the Small Animal Office and pick up their packets which include any passes ordered. If additional passes are required, Exhibitor must come to the Livestock Office in the Livestock Pavilion and purchase those passes.

Small Animal Exhibitor Passes:

4H/FFA Livestock Exhibitor Wristband (1 per exhibitor) (must be entered in Livestock show)...	\$10.00
Livestock Exhibitor Wristband (all ages)	\$35.00
South Lot Parking (good for all 11 days)	\$45.00

- **4H/FFA Livestock Exhibitor Wristbands are for exhibitor only – 1 will be issued per exhibitor – additional 4H/FFA wristbands ordered under an exhibitor’s name will be charged the \$35.00 for the all-age Livestock Exhibitor band.**
- All-age Livestock Exhibitor Wristbands should be purchased for the parents/grandparents/friends of 4H/FFA exhibitors unless they elect to purchase daily tickets.
- Vehicles not parked in the correct parking space or lot areas will be towed at owner’s expense. No exceptions! Vehicles not possessing the correct or expired permits will be towed at owner’s expense. No exceptions.
