ALL PARTICIPANTS 18 AND UNDER ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HELMET

- No cross-entry in age groups/High point divisions; age as of January 1, 2019
- Novice is any horse or rider in their first year of showing or not to have won 3 classes in that event.
- To qualify for a Hi-Point/Reserve Champion, participants must enter in required classes for their age division, please refer to schedule page for required classes.
- Tradition show attire not required; however, boots, long pants, and long-sleeve shirts are required.
- Schooling is allowed in any class so long as it is not disruptive. It is the discretion of the judge and show committee as to what is disruptive. If you do not qualify to be in that class you must turn your number upside down to indicate you are schooling.
- Classes may be added, combined, split, or cancelled, at the discretion of the Columbia County Open Horse Show Committee
- Ribbons to 6th place
- No overnight stalls available
- Participants enter the Columbia County Fairgrounds property at their own risk and are subject to facility rules and regulations. Refunds only to participants who provide a note or excuse from a medical doctor/veterinarian.
- **VET Checks are required for ALL horses using a stall.** If you miss the vet check you will not be allowed a stall. Times for the vet check will be 7- 10 am on the morning of the show.
