## **Columbia County Fair Camping Information and Rules**

**Weekly camping is from July 14-21, 2019. Weekly campers will be given spaces inside the fenced camping area as long as space is available. Weekly campers are allowed to move in at any time between the 14<sup>th</sup> and the 20<sup>th</sup> during camping superintendent hours. Cars will not be allowed to park inside the fenced camping area. A designated spot will be given to each camper adjacent to campsite.**

**Nightly campers pay on a per night basis and will be camping outside the fenced camping area.**

- Camping is intended for those attending/ participating in the Fair & Rodeo. Fair admission will be required.
- Dry camping only, no fires in the campground at any time.
- All campers must check in with the camping superintendent prior to set up.
- All vehicles will park in a designated parking area outside the fenced camping area adjacent to camping. Vehicles will only be allowed to bring in one initial load of supplies but will not be allowed to stay or park in the camping area. (This will allow more camping spaces inside the fence)
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed outside of an individual campsite. No bar set ups, kegs or alcohol banners are allowed inside the campground.
- All campers under the age of 21 require an adult (over 21) chaperone throughout their stay. Campers under 21 are not to be left unattended overnight.
- Quiet time is from 10pm each day until 7am each morning. Generators can run only in non-quiet time hours.
- No pets in campground.
- Campsites remaining 48 hours after close of Fair will be removed at the owner's expense.
- Failure to comply with these rules will result in removal from the campground

**All gates will be locked 1 hour after the closing of fair.**

**In case of emergency Fair Security and the Camping Superintendent will have gate keys**
