4. Winter heifer calf born between 12/1/19 and 2/28/20
5. Fall heifer calf born between 9/1/19 and 11/30/19

### **Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer**

6. Summer yearling heifer born between 6/1/19 and 8/31/19
7. Spring yearling heifer born between 3/1/19 and 5/31/19
8. Winter yearling born between 12/1/17 and 2/28/18
9. Fall yearling heifer born between 9/1/19 and 11/30/19

### **Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer**

10. Milking Yearling Heifer born 8/31/18 and after)
11. Junior two-year-old cow born between 3/1/18 and 8/31/18
12. Senior two-year-old cow born between 9/1/17 and 2/28/18
13. Junior three-year-old cow born between 3/1/17 and 8/31/17
14. Senior three-year-old cow born between 9/1/17 and 2/28/18
15. Four-year-old cow (9/1/15 – 8/31/16)
16. Five-year-old cow (9/1/14 – 8/31/15)
17. Six-year-old cow and older cow born before 9/1/14)

### **Cow Champion and Reserve Champion**

18. Dairy Herd-Four cows all freshened, owned by exhibitor. One entry per exhibitor
19. Junior Get of Sire-Four animals under 2 years, either sex
20. Get of Sire-Four animals, one to be at least 2 years old; no more than 2 bulls  
One entry per exhibitor
21. Produce of Dam-Two animals any age, any sex. One entry per exhibitor
