Cow Palace Evacuation Center Donations Needed

Daly City, California – August 25, 2020 The Cow Palace Arena and Event Center was activated by San Mateo County Office of Emergency Services on August 20, 2020 to receive livestock and horses evacuated due to the CZU Lightning Complex Fires. Animals have been coming in since Friday but there is still plenty of room for more. To date, the Cow Palace is housing 296 animals ranging from horse and cows to llamas and peacocks.

“It is quite a menagerie of animals” said Lori Marshall, CEO of the Cow Palace. “It has been an honor working with all of the volunteers who are making this evacuation run so smoothly and helping so many ensure the safety of their beloved animals.”
