## Your Generosity Gives Hope

Our town is great. If you live here, then you know what I'm talking about. We do our best to take care of each other, and we go out of our way to help those in need. We do these things, not because we expect something in return, but because helping others is the right thing to do. A helpful and giving populace is what makes a town a great place to live in, and that's the exact reason why Luling is such a remarkable place to call home. Lending a helping hand to someone does much more than just put food on the table, it gives hope. I have been a part of the Night in Old Luling Association for quite some time now, and have seen first- hand the positive impact that has been made in our community by helping others. For well over two decades the NIOL Association has worked closely with other non-profit organizations to help raise money for those in need.

One organization that NIOL has helped in the past is the Luling Area Ministerial Alliance (LAMA). LAMA oversees the Food Bank that is housed on the grounds of the Foundation Farm. The Food Bank serves about 800 needy people per month, which translates to approximately 100,000 pounds of food each year. The Alliance was able to renovate the Food Bank and purchase appliances with funds raised by the NIOL Association. With these much needed repairs; LAMA can now continue their mission of helping the needy in our community.

This year's recipient will be St. Johns Parish Hall. The Hall has been used by the community for more than 4 decades for a variety of purposes, such as: blood drives, community dinners, an evacuation center, festivals, an LISD testing site, a meeting center, and a mammography screening center. Individuals or families in need may also find assistance within the walls of the Parish Hall. It serves as a hub for the needy; where food, clothes, furniture, and monetary help can be made available. The caretakers of the Parish Hall will use the funds to renovate the kitchen area, and to purchase much needed kitchen appliances. As you can see, helping just a small group of people can have a profound effect on our community. Helping just one group can allow for hundreds, even thousands, of lives to be reached with lasting effects.
