The committee went over the updated Fair schedule and decided that only 28 volunteers. No volunteers will be needed for the info booths or handing out souvenir programs this year.

The committee decide that there will be no volunteer orientation this year. Instead, volunteers show up 30 minutes early for the information they would normally receive at orientation.

The committee asked and received clarification on what each specific area of Fair will look like from the public's standpoint. The 4-H shows will take place, no public will be allowed to attend. Guest Service will not have to provide volunteers for the 4-H shows. For the rodeos and the livestock sale, spectators will be asked to stay separated and in their respective areas. There will be portapotties available in each area. Parking will be handled by an outside company. Ushers for the rodeo will be handled by an outside company as well. Yellow shirt volunteers will not need to control where people are going and where they are sitting. There will be food trucks available for spectators.

Several people have reached out to the Fair Office about volunteering opportunities and Michelle has emailed those to Dean and Jean. Four people have signed up that are not LDS missionaries.

Wendy Holmes with the county is working on an advertising plan to send out information out to the general public. This includes buyers for the Livestock Sale. This has been a moving target with things changing daily.

Jean let the committee know that two weeks ago, there was a petition going around to residents asking them to sign a petition to make sure there is a Fair. No other committee members knew about this.

Dean and Sonia both reminded the committee that things are constantly changing and to please have some flexibility as we move forward. Everyone is on the same team and will all cover whatever we need to.

Sonia informed the committee again that all tickets will be sold online via TicketMaster. There will be a large banner in front of the Fairgrounds to let the public know that tickets are on sale and will change when tickets are sold out. If people come to the Fairgrounds to buy tickets, they can go on to Ticket Master.
