Synneva started out the meeting by explaining that the decision had been made to cancel all entertainment for 2020. The reasoning behind the decision was that there will not be enough public at the Fair, if any, to justify the expense. Synneva asked Pam if she had anything to add.

Pam stated that the variance requested is basically just for the 4-H Shows, Livestock Sale and Rodeos. She explained that because there won't be a tremendous amount of people at the Fairgrounds, it doesn't make to have entertainment. She also noted that even working out the logistics for the 4-H and PRCA events is a lot of work and still many people, such as the Livestock Sale Buyers, may have to participate virtually due to crowd restraints under the public health order.

Lora said she wasn't surprised by the news and also said that modifying the Livestock Sale is probably going to be quite expensive. She also inquired if the PRCA had guidelines for the coronavirus like PBR does and Pam said yes.

Lora said she was thinking of joining the Rodeo or Livestock Sale Committee. Pam thanked her for her willingness to help. Lora said she would attend some meetings and see where she fits in.
