Auction Options: The committee discussed different auction options for 2021.

In person, online or hybrid: The consensus from the committee is to find a software option that can do both an in person and online auction even if just the add-on portion of the sale is online.

Software: The consensus from the committee is to use ShoWorks for this year because the software can do a hybrid sale or just an online sale depending on COVID-19 restrictions. There is an additional cost of 1% total commission from the sale that the committee will be asking Fair Foundation to help cover.

Budget: The committee budget is the same as it was in 2019 and 2020.

Hats: The committee would like to see a sample of the teal hats discussed at a previous meeting.

Caterer: Michelle will send out a request for quote to several different companies and will provide the quotes at the next meeting.

Unpaid Invoices: The committee would like to draft a letter to send to individuals with outstanding balances from the 2020 sale. This letter will state that until the outstanding balance is paid, the buyer will not be able to register to bid at future sales.

Comments: Phil will contact Divis trucking as they did a great job last year. The committee agreed to ask back the same auctioneers as 2020. Phil will reach out to them for availability.
