

	<ul> <li>♦ Writing at school: Must be done in one hour time period at the school under teacher's supervision.</li> <li>Provide scoring rubric to studentsthe day before writing to help them understand how they will be evaluated.</li> <li>Three top essays from each grade will be selected by the teacher or other designated judges at the school level.</li> <li>After selected, top 3 students may make minor edits and corrections under teacher's supervision.</li> <li>Writing is done in the Fall to allow ample time for judging essays and releasing results in early January.</li> </ul>	NO pre-writing activities may be done. Check rules for allowed length of essay. Those exceeding the "grace" limit will NOT be judged. Scoring Rubric is provided in the e-mail with the Writing Prompt.
