Costumes, parking and admission for on-duty volunteers will be provided along with a 25% discount in The Shops at Storowton.

Storowton also has short-term, seasonal opportunities for teens to gain experience working with children, to learn and demonstrate leadership skills and even gain volunteer hours for service projects or honor societies. Our junior counselor program gives young teens the chance to work with senior counselors and museum staff at the Early American Summer Days and Pioneer Kids Week programs.
