BEEF RULES

a) All beef health records must accompany animals to the Fair.

- b) All steer participants must have submitted a beef identification card listing state tag number and other ear tag information along with a negative BVD report by January 4, 2019.
- c) Steers and heifers must have a state ear tag (RFID) which is to be used as positive identification on the official beef entry form and health papers.
- d) All cattle must have been tested and had a negative result for BVD (Bovine Viral Diarrhea).
- e) Steers must weigh at least <u>1,000 lbs.</u> at time of Fair weigh-in or they will not be eligible for the show or sale. All steers will be weighed **ONE TIME ONLY and NO SUBSTITUTIONS** will be allowed. If a member registered a spare steer on 1-5-18, that animal may be weighed if the primary steer does not make weight and it is present on the fair grounds.
- f) Beef tie-outs All steers are required to be housed in the 4-H Beef Barn throughout the Fair. Heifers may be tied out in the area provided at the owner's discretion. However, 4-H members must sign a waiver before tie out is permitted.
- g) Breeding Animals MUST submit a copy of the registration form with their Fair Entry.
- h) Market steers must have been administered a rabies vaccine on or before July 23, 2019 in order to adhere to the 21 days withholding period.
- i) All exhibitors must be able to lead/control entered beef animals at all times. Members who cannot control their animals may be asked to take uncontrollable animals home. This decision will be made by the Beef Advisory Committee and Extension Educator to ensure the safety of all exhibitors and the general public.
- j) Breeding Beef exhibitors must be 8 as of January 1, 2019.
- k) Market Steer exhibitors must be 9 as of January 1, 2019.
- l) All exhibitors <u>must</u> have given a public presentation prior to May 2019.
- m) All fans must be securely hung at a safe height. No butt fans or fan stands will be allowed. This rule has been put into place for the safety of the program participants as well as the fairgoers. No more than 1 fan per 4-H family, all fans must be blowing to the sides of all cattle
- n) Market Steers will be sold on Saturday, August 17, 2019 at 1:00 PM. ALL exhibitors are responsible for maintaining their exhibit until released by the 4-H program on Sunday, August 18, 2019 at 9:00 PM. Failure to do so will result in not being able to participate at The Erie County Fair in the future and forfeit of premium checks. (See CCE regulations in your hand book)
- o) No colored mulch may be used for bedding. Only shavings, straw or bark (non colored) is acceptable.
- p) Coaching from the side lines will not be permitted. Spectators or fellow 4-H member found coaching a youth in the show ring will be asked to leave by the show personnel.
- q) Steers that are not shown in the beef show (animals pulled from the show at the owner's discretion) <u>must</u> leave the fairgrounds and are not permitted on a 4-H hired trailer.

Please Note: NEW for 2019- No setting up of exhibits will be allowed until 6:00am on Tuesday August 13, 2019. No cattle are to arrive until 6:00am and will be enforced by both 4-H and the Erie County Fair.
