## Llama/Alpaca RULES

- a) All Llama and Alpaca health records must accompany animals to the Fair. All llamas/alpacas must show proof of active immunization against rabies, and must be negative to an approved test appropriate to detect Bovine Viral Diarrhea persistent infection (BVD-PI).
- b) Llamas and Alpacas must be identified by a microchip that is to be used as positive identification on the official entry form and health papers. All animals must have been identified by June 1, 2019 through the submission of a Llama/Alpaca identification card listing microchip information to the 4-H office. (paperwork includes: Llama/Alpaca enrollment and Llama/Alpaca Lease agreement showing all registration information of the animal being leased)
- c) Exhibitors shall be neat and clean wearing dress shirt and dark pants or skirt, closed toe shoes.
- d) Breeding Animals MUST submit a copy of the registration form to the 4-H office by June 1, 2019.
- e) All participants must be 8 years old as of January 1, 2019.
- f) All exhibitors must have given a public presentation prior to May 2019.
- g) All exhibitors must submit a completed record book at the exhibitor meeting on Thursday, August 8 at 12:30 p.m. in Barn 1
- h) All exhibitors must have participated in three (3) Erie County 4-H Llama/Alpaca educational meetings to be eligible to show at the fair.
- i) **ALL exhibitors are responsible for maintaining their exhibit until released by the 4-H program on Monday August 12, 2019, failure to do so will result in not being able to participate at The Erie County Fair in the future and forfeit of premium checks. (See CCE regulations in your handbook)**

Llamas/Alpacas showing in the open show and staying for the 4-H show will continue their stay in Barn 1.

All ages for showmanship are as of January 1 of the current year.

**Class # 3 – Intermediate Showmanship** – 13 – 15 years old as of 1/01/2019

**Class # 4 - Junior Showmanship** – 8 – 12 years old as of 1/01/2019

Entries for this class are limited to the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place showman from classes 2-4.

Classes will be divided if there are more than 4 animals in a specific age category.

### Llama/Alpaca Male Halter (all colors shown together)

- Class # 21 **Llama Young Male:** under the age of 3 years on show day.  
Class # 22 **Llama Older Male:** over the age of 3 years on show day.  
Class # 23 **Alpaca Young Male:** under the age of 3 years on show day.  
Class # 24 **Alpaca Older Male:** over the age of 3 years on show day.

**A Best in Show Llama and Best in Show Alpaca will be selected from the above three categories (male, non-breeder, and female).**

**Obstacle and Public Relations:** We will select a Grand and Reserve Champion in the Performance divisions (Obstacle and Public Relations). This award will be presented to a youth who shows overall excellence by placing well in performance classes. Youth must compete in both the Obstacle and Public Relations classes. Points will be accumulated. The same animal must be used in both classes.
