General Arts & Crafts Rules

1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday July 19, 2019. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
3. All work must have been done by the exhibitor **within the last 5 years.**
4. Excellent kit work will be accepted; however, preference in judging will be given to creative and original work.
5. Quality of articles is the main consideration for judging. All items must be clean & dust removed.
6. More than one first (blue) and second (red) may be awarded in each class, if warranted.
7. Should there be no deserving entries in any class, no premium will be awarded.
8. **No entry exceeding in overall size of 36" x 36" will be accepted** unless otherwise specified.
9. No plastic canvas (except Section ACG Class #5, Section ACP Class #5, Section ACV Class #1)

Definitions

Amateur- A person who engages as a beginner and does for pleasure.

Professional- An expert or business practice

2. Santa Claus or Father Christmas figure, any medium (**14" Height Maximum**)

ACH-DRESSED ANIMALS (animal and clothing must be handmade by the exhibitor)

ACI- EGGS (STAND REQUIRED)

1. Hand Painted (**STAND REQUIRED**)
2. Any Medium, other than hand painted (**STAND REQUIRED**)

ACJ-FABRIC / CLOTH WALL HANGINGS (42" x 59" MAXIMUM SIZE) WITH HANGER (TO INCLUDE FRAME)

ACN- LEATHER WORK – METALWORK MAX SIZE: 36"W x 40"L

ACO-NATURE CRAFTS

1. Painted slate – **12" x 14" Maximum**
2. Painted rocks - **12" Diameter Maximum**
3. Painted Gourds- Decorative
4. Sculptures with natural materials
5. Fiber art/ felting item
6. Any item in classes 1-5 created by exhibitor 70 years old or older

ACP- OTHER ITEMS- HAND PAINTED, STENCILED, NEEDLE ART OR STAMPED

1. Placemat
2. Napkin Rings
3. Painted Ceramics (purchased plate, but hand painted)
4. Plastic Canvas Center Piece
5. Centerpiece- any other medium
6. Any item in classes 1-5 created by exhibitor 70 years old or older

ACQ- ROOM BOXES, DIORAMA'S & DOLLHOUSES

1. Room Boxes – **MAXIMUM 25"W x 15"H x 13"D – NO EXCEPTIONS (completely enclosed in glass or plexi-glass)**
2. Diorama – **MAXIMUM 21"W x 19"D x 18 ½"H - NO EXCEPTIONS (completely enclosed in glass or plexi-glass)**
3. Dollhouses – **MAXIMUM 33"W x 33 "H x 11"D**
4. Any item in classes 1-3 created by exhibitor 70 years old or older

ACR-SCRAPBOOKING – CREATIVITY & IMAGINATION

***Note: Most creative use of embellishments, stickers, quilling etc. No needle point or cross stitch items. All pages should be in sheet protectors.**

1. *NEW* Christmas/ Holiday Cards/Invitation
2. *NEW* Birthday Cards/ Invitation
3. Other Cards/ Invitation
4. Gift tags
5. Photo books (**maximum of 4 pages – not to exceed 12" x 12" book size**)
6. Mini Books
7. Mini Paper Bag
8. Legacy/ Story Books- (not to exceed 12"x12" book size)
9. *NEW* Waterfall Books
10. Any item in classes 1-9 created by exhibitor 70 years old or older

ACS- SCULPTING

1. Figures – hand sculpted
2. Pottery – hand thrown
3. Clay Items
4. Any Other that does not fit in the above categories
5. Any item in classes 1-4 created by exhibitor 70 years old or older

ACT- WOOD WORKING (No piece larger than: 36" x 36" x 30" will be accepted unless otherwise specified)

All pieces must be hand fashioned. No found wood or drift wood.

1. Any original functional piece (NO CLOCKS)
2. Any original decorative or amusing piece (NO CLOCKS OR TOYS)
3. Clock – wood case
4. Toy
5. Child or doll sized furniture – natural or painted finish
6. Decorative painting on wood
7. Ship model – (maximum size of 45" x 42" including case/enclosure)
8. Bird carving or animal carving – natural or painted finish
9. Miscellaneous carving – natural or painted finish
10. Shadow box – natural or painted finish - must be hand fashioned
11. Any item in classes 1-10 created by exhibitor 70 years old or older

ACU- TABLE FAVORS

1. Wedding Favor
2. Bridal Shower Favor
3. Baby Shower Favor
4. Birthday Favor
5. Any other that does not fit in the above categories.
6. Any item in classes 1-5 created by exhibitor 70 years old or older

ACV- ARTS & CRAFTS SENIORS/MISC

1. Any item created using plastic canvas by an exhibitor 70 years old or older

The specifics –

We will provide a five-gallon bucket of unique pieces, probably otherwise known as “junk”. All the buckets will include the same number of items and be **as close to identical as possible**. You can clean, sand, weld, glue, cut, bolt, fasten, bend, shape, paint or finish the items that were provide BUT no pieces can be added. Create whatever you want with the contents of your bucket. The goal is to use all the items in the bucket (but not the bucket). The projects **will** be displayed inside.

Bucket of Junk Contest Rules

1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. **All entries must be pre-registered by MONDAY JUNE 24, 2019** Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
3. Anyone over 18 years old is eligible to enter this contest.
4. One reservation per family or household. The project may be the group effort of a family or household.
5. There will be ten (10) bucket of junk reservations available starting May 1st. The first 10 reservations will be informed by mail when they can pick up their buckets. Please send in your entry form early, reservations go fast!
6. Sculptures are to be brought to the Creative Arts Exhibit Area on the Fairgrounds.
7. When you bring your creation to the Fairgrounds please bring back the bucket.
8. **Exhibitors are only allowed to enter the Bucket of Junk contest once every two years, meaning 2018 Bucket of Junk exhibitors are currently ineligible for the 2019 Erie County Fair Bucket of Junk Contest.**
9. If after receiving the items, you realize you will not be able to complete the project, please bring items back to the office and we will contact the next person on the waiting list.

As Seen On Pinterest Contest Rules

1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. Entry must include a print page of the Pinterest Pin (Pinterest logo must be visible on the page)
3. Entry must include a typed set of step by step instructions that you took to create your craft. Be sure to include any variations that may have been used.
4. Size restriction: craft must not exceed 36” in any direction.
5. A copy of the step by step instructions will be retained by the Erie County Fair and the winners will be posted to the website ecfair.org as well as pinned to the Erie County Fair’s Pinterest account.
6. Judge may break entries into separate classes if deemed necessary.

JUDGING:

Difficulty (was an intricate process used in the making of the craft) – 30%

Accuracy (does the craft reflect the idea of the Pinterest Post) – 30%

Eye Appeal (overall finished appearance, complementing colors, etc.) – 40%
