

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Stalls will be available starting August 08, 2019 at 3:00 PM for a fee of \$40 per stall for the weekend. Requests for stalls must be made by Wednesday August 07, 2019. Please call the Horse Show Office at 716-649-3900 ext. 435 for reservations. **HORSES MAY NOT ARRIVE BEFORE WEDNESDAY AUGUST 07 AT 3:00 PM.**
2. All exhibitors must pay the mandatory \$15.00 office fee (except if they are a member of the Erie County Agricultural Society) to show at the Erie County Fair Horse Show.
3. All exhibitors must comply with the New York Livestock Requirements:
  - a) Equine Infectious Anemia Test (EIA/Coggins) a valid EIA chart documenting that the animal has been tested (any USDA approved test) within the current or previous calendar year (2017 and 2018 for this Fair season), and found to be negative for EIA infection, is required of all equines 6 months of age and older. The animal identification noted on all accompanying documents must match the description on the official EIA chart.
  - b) Rabies Vaccination-Proof of active immunization against rabies required.
5. We request you send a photocopy of your Coggins and Rabies Certificates along with your entries to speed up processing.
6. All reservations for stalls, entries, parking, etc. must be accompanied with payment in full (check or money order payable to the Erie County Agricultural Society) and mailed to:
7. Camper Spots will be available for the Open Show from August 08-11, 2019. Camper Passes will be available at the horse show office for a fee of \$25.00 per night.

### High Point Awards

High Point awards will be presented following the Open Show on Saturday in the following divisions:

Beginner- Youth- Open- The High Point in each of those 3 divisions will receive an Erie County Fair High Point Cooler- High Point Ribbon and a \$100.00 cash award!!

Points accumulated from the first 2 days will be added together to determine the High Point Winners.

Points will be awarded to the top 6 in each class this way – 10-6-4-2-1-0.5

The classes that will count towards High Point will be the following:

The Erie County Fair Horse Show is proud to offer, in cooperation with her many friends in Western New York, the Carol Russo Memorial Walk-Trot Division.

Those who knew Carol knew that horses were her lifelong passion. Fittingly, that love has provided a forum that will afford many young riders an opportunity to ride and fulfill their dreams. We remember her as a champion competitor and know she is smiling, knowing that some children may follow in her footsteps.

Though her life was short, her love of the sport and horses has ignited a love within many young children. As they learn to ride they help to create a legacy she would be proud of.

This division is open to any breed of horse or pony that is ridden by a Walk-Trot exhibitor. No Walk-Trot rider may compete in any class at this show which requires entries to lope or canter.

### CAMPER LOT RULES

Camper parking must be requested on the entry form. Payment must accompany requests. Camper stickers will be AVAILABLE UPON ARRIVAL. All camper spaces include electric hookups only. Spaces will be accommodated in two locations; in the Horse Show Camper Lot, (For trailers in this area all tow vehicles MUST be removed). In the Grey Lot, which is located behind Ring II, tow vehicles may remain attached. Spaces will be allocated in the order the payment is received. Campers without prior approval will not be permitted in the camper area. NO TENTS. Any changes must be approved by the Horse Show Manager. Horse trailers, passenger vehicles, vans without factory installed living quarters, etc. will NOT be allowed in camper areas. In the event sufficient camper parking is not available in the stabling area, management reserves the right to assign campers to another area on the grounds.

At the direction of the New York State Department of Health and in order to maintain our operating permit, the following regulations must be implemented and adhered to at all times.

1. A five (5) foot separation between each unit/extremities MUST be maintained on all sides. This measurement is from the furthest extremity, slide out or other apparatus.
2. No bonfires/campfires
3. No open flames of any type, including propane grills, charcoal, cook stoves etc.
4. No awnings are allowed in the down position
5. Do NOT block the roadways with any personal vehicles
6. All fire lanes must be maintained at all times.
7. Speed limit is 5mph.
8. No gray water dumping is permitted in any lot. (*Scavenger services are available by contacting the manager*)
9. Outside cooking is permitted in designated areas only and must be a minimum of twenty five (25) feet from any structure or unit.
10. ALL units MUST have a fire extinguisher or method of fire protection available.
11. Vehicles must have appropriate pass to be permitted in the RV Parking.
12. No alcoholic containers are allowed outside of the RV's.
13. Any child under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times while in the RV Parking.
14. Quiet hours are 11pm-7am
15. All spaces MUST be pre-paid prior to arrival.
16. NO gray water dumping (a scavenger service is available, go the Horse Show Office). All residents will be responsible to go the Horse Show Office to pay for a pump by 7PM the night before to get on the pump schedule for the next day. ***If not signed up by 7PM the night previous, you will NOT get pumped.***
17. The pump truck will **only** pump those that have paid and are on the list provided. Payment per pump is \$35.00. ***No pumps will be completed without payment!***
18. When you sign up at the Horse Show Office to get your camper pumped you will need:
  - a. \$35 for the pump.
  - b. Camper license plate number.
  - c. Brand of camper

Failure to comply with regulations will result in loss of privileges and immediate removal of the unit.
