HOW TO WAGER

1. State the TRACK & RACE NUMBER to wager.
2. State the DOLLAR AMOUNT of wager.
3. Tell the TYPE OF WAGER to make (Win, Place, Show, Trifecta, etc.)
4. State the NUMBER of the horse(s) on which to bet.

EXAMPLE: "I would like to wager on the 2nd race at Oaklawn. \$2 to Win on horse number 8."

TYPES OF WAGERS

Win	When you bet a horse to win, you win if your horse finishes first.
Place	When you bet a horse to place, you win if your horse finishes first or second.
Show	When you bet a horse to show, you win if your horse finishes first, second or third.
Daily Double	Choose the winners of two races. Wagers must be placed prior to the first race of the Daily Double.
Quinella	Choose the two horses finishing first and second in either order.
Exacta	Choose the two horses finishing first and second in exact order.
Trifecta	Choose the first three finishers in exact order.
Superfecta	Choose the first four finishers in exact order.
Pick 3	Choose the winner of three consecutive races. Wagers must be placed before the first of the three races.
Pick 6	Choose the winner of six consecutive races. Wagers must be placed before the first of the six races.
Box	Box wagers, such as exactas, trifectas or superfecta bets. This places a bet for all combinations of the numbers in the box. An exacta box with 2 horses has 2 possible combinations and costs 2 times the betting base amount.

RACING TERMS

Across the board - a bet made on one horse to win, place or show.	Fast - the preferred rating surface is dry, firm and even.	Muddy - a wet, sticky racing surface.
Age - all race horses in the northern hemisphere arbitrarily celebrate their birthday on January 1.	Filly - Female horse (4-year-old or younger).	Objection - is a claim of foul lodged by a jockey or trainer.
Backstretch - the straightaway of the track away from the grandstand.	Furlong - One-eighth of a mile.	Parimutuels - a betting system whereby bettors collect on the total money wagered after deduction of the house percentage.
Colors - color designations in horses:	Good - still drying but is almost "fast".	Route - Race distance greater than one mile.
Bay - Brownish coat with black points	Handle - the sum of all wagers bet on a race during specified period of time.	Scratch - a horse that has been withdrawn from a race.
Black - All Black	Inquiry - is a claim of foul lodged by a racing official.	Sloppy - a track so saturated with rain that it has water lying on the surface.
Chestnut - A reddish brown color	Juvenile - 2 year-old horses.	Slow - a track with a muddy surface which is beginning to dry out.
Gray/Roan - Combination of white hairs with any one or several of the above noted colors.	Length - measure of distance based on average length of a horse.	Sprint - Race distance less than one mile.
Colt - a male horse (4-year-old or younger).	Mare - a female horse (5-year-old or older).	
Derby - stakes race for 3-year-olds.	Maiden - a horse which has not won a race.
