Live Competition: Students will prepare their recipe onsite at **The Silo Event Center -** Kitchen, 9036 Brittany Way, Tampa Fl. 33619, to be judged by a panel of professional

judges.

FEB 6-17, 2020 Winning students can prepare their recipes in the Demo Kitchen

at the Florida State Fair in the Florida Center Building.

Categories

1. Anything On a Stick Item can be sweet or savory.

2. Grilled Sandwich Sandwich must use a bread product. All burgers must be

composed of grilled patties (formed from any meat), served on buns, other bread products, or alternative wrappings.

3. Deep Fried Anything Item can be sweet or savory which is dipped and battered.

Funnel cake submissions must be at least 50% funnel cake

batter

4. Surprise Us Something so unique we have not thought of a category.

Entry Rules

1. No Entry Fee!

2. Students may compete individually or as a team of no more than 2 students.

3. Students or teams of two may submit up to two (2) different recipes, however, only one (1) entry per category.

4. A student's entry must be an original creation and may not include copyrighted, trademarked, patented, or previously published material.

Judging Process

Step One – Students will submit an Entry Form

Step Two – Live Competition: Students will compete at the **The Silo Event Center -** Kitchen, 9036 Brittany Way, Tampa Fl. 33619, and be judged by a panel of 4 judges.

Students will provide all their own ingredients. Food must be transported safely in ice chests and not bags, temperature sensitive items need to be in ice chest. Students will bring their own equipment, including table top fryers, griddles, burners, and toaster/ ovens. Electrical outlets are available at every station. Minimal refrigerator space is available.

Students should dress in chef's uniform (hat or hair net, closed toe shoes, pants, and chef coat or apron).

Preparation/Cooking/Cleanup: Students will be given 45 minutes total (5 minutes of setup, 30 minutes of cooking, and 10 minutes of cleaning).

Presentation: Students should be prepared to verbally present their dish under 1 minute and answer questions from judges.

Team competition times will be announced on or before Friday, DEC 7th, 2019.

Guidelines for judging

■ Presentation by the student(s) — 10%

How well the student(s) present their recipe to the judges. How well do they answer questions and respond to feedback from the judges.

- Taste 40%
- Name & Crowd Appeal 5%:

Would your recipe's name appeal to fair goers? Does the recipe sound appetizing?

Visual Appeal — 15%:

Does the recipe make you want to eat this before you even smell or taste it?

Creativity — 15%:

Is this recipe creative and one of a kind?
Is the recipe reflective of unique twists to ingredient usage?

Safety & Sanitation — 10%:

Did the student use proper knife safety and avoid cross-contamination, and did they clean their station within the designated time frame?

■ Ease of Preparation — 5%:

How easy is the preparation?

Can you make it with only basic cooking equipment?

Is the recipe written in a clear and concise manner?
