Entry Rules

General Rules



1. Contest is limited to the first 50 artists to send in their entry form and registration fee (either online or by mail).

Artwork (check-in and painting)

2. All paintings must be created on Florida State Fairgrounds on Monday, February 10th, 2020, between 7 am – 8 pm.
3. **Check-In and stamping of back of canvas must occur before the artist is allow to paint.**
 - **Check-In instructions** will be sent along with Fair Tickets and parking information, prior to February 10th.
 - A Fair volunteer will assist you in setting up work area. They will be available throughout the day if needed: *For example; the volunteer can sit in your area if you need to go get something to eat.*
 - You will be given credentials and a flag to hang to display in your area.
4. Types of media may include: oils, acrylics, water media, pastels & graphite
5. No photographs or iPad can be used to create the paintings.

Submission & Sale of Paintings

6. **Contestants may submit a maximum of two signed painting**
7. **Artists must drop off the framed or unframed wrapped canvases by 8 pm on Monday, February 10th, 2020.**
 - **Check-in stamp must be visible on the back of each painting in order to be accepted.**
 - Paintings must be appropriately framed, mounted and securely wired for hanging. Artwork with clip mounts, missing wires, string, scotch tape or saw tooth hangers ***WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.***
 - All submitted exhibit art must be for sale and remain in the exhibit until the end of the Fair.
 - In keeping with the Florida State Fair's family orientation, items of an offensive, controversial or objectionable nature or subject matter will not be accepted.
8. **Maximum submission size:**
 - **Unframed Painting** - can be any size as long as it does not exceed 320 square inches (equivalent to a 16 x 20 inch canvas)
 - **Framed Painting** - can be any size as long as it does not exceed 480 square inches (includes outside dimension of frame - equivalent to a 20 x 24 inch)
9. **Selling and pickup of paintings**
 - **Pricing:** Artists can set the price of their painting but cannot change the price after painting has been submitted for judging.
 - **Commission:** The Florida State Fair will retain a 20% commission on all paintings sold during the Fair. Artists will receive payment within a month of the Fair ending.

If a painting is purchased during the fair it will not be allowed to be removed by the purchaser until after the fair.
 - **Pick-Up artwork:** Sold and un-sold paintings can be picked up between February 18-22 (hours: 11 am – 6 pm). Special arrangements can be made with Creative Living Office if you are unable to pick up your items on those dates or times.
 - All entries not claimed by **September 1st** of the same year will be recycled, disposed or donated through our program department.

How it all works

If you are one of the first 30 to submit an entry form, you will be sent an email letting you know you are in the contest. We will mail you one fair ticket with check-in & parking instructions. We will direct you where to Check-In on Monday, February 10th.



How to Enter Online

We encourage you to enter online, using ShoWorks. The Florida State Fair has implemented ShoWorks, an on-line entry program. ShoWorks is an industry standard used by over 50 fairs nationally. This user-friendly program can be trusted to accurately enter you into our competitions and allows for efficient communications via e-mail. We are excited to have ShoWorks to better facilitate entering Florida State Fair competitions.

- **To Enter Online using ShoWorks.**

Go to **www.floridastatefair.com** and at the top of the home page select the **2020 Fair** TAB and you will see in the dropdown list a link for **Creative Living Competitions**. Select the **Enter Online** link at the top right of that page.

- **Everyone must register as a new exhibitor each year.**
- **Note that sessions expire after 20 minutes** of inactivity, so “save the cart” if you plan on leaving the computer for more than 20 minutes.
- When registering, please verify that all information that you entered into ShoWorks is correct. Please pay special attention to capitalization, full names of cities/counties and use proper spelling (no abbreviations).
- You can pay fees with a credit card or mail in a check.

Mailing Paper Entry Forms

Entry Forms must be postmarked by Friday, December 13, 2019.

Failure to complete any portion of entry form may result in disqualification.

Contest is limited to the first 50 artists to send in their entry form and registration fee.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to be a professional artist to participate?

No, all levels and experience are welcome

How old do you need to be to participate? *At least 18 years of age or older.*

Can I sell my work?

Yes. The artist sets the price of their piece. A 20% commission on all pieces sold goes to the Florida State Fair. You do not need to list your work for sale.

Do I have to get model releases? *The Florida State Fair is not requiring model releases.*
