Pioneers and Cowhunters

Cracker Country, Tampa's only outdoor living history museum, welcomes home educators and students to Homeschool Day on **November 6, 2017, from 10:00am-2:00pm.**

The theme of the event is "Pioneers and Cowhunters". Educational interpreters in historic dress will guide young learners through activities that would have been familiar to a child growing up in a Florida farming and ranching community over 100 years ago. Try your hand at churning butter, helping with the household chores, making your own toy and taking a lesson in a one-room school house. Learn some "cowhunter" skills, like how to swing a lasso and what to pack for a long cattle drive.

Tickets are available for purchase online at www.crackercountry.org. *This event is very popular so advance ticket purchase is recommended.* Admission: \$8 per person, ages 4-adult. Children 3 and under are admitted free. Visitors will receive FREE parking for this event when they enter the Fairgrounds via the Orient Road entrance.

Mildred W. and Doyle E. Carlton, Jr. Cracker Country is a rural Florida living history museum located at the Florida State Fairgrounds. The museum includes a collection of 13 original buildings dating from 1870-1912 on four acres of grounds and gardens.
