Texan wins first two rounds of bull riding at Fort Worth

FORT WORTH, Texas (Jan. 25, 2020)—Jamie Howlett of Rapid City, South Dakota, has been riding bareback bucking horses in the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) for five years. He also competed in college rodeo in the U.S. and at rodeos in his home country of Australia, but he had never scored 90 points or more until Saturday.

At the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo's (FWSSR) ProRodeo Tournament Saturday night, Howlett scored 90.5 points on Northcott-Macza Pro Rodeo's mare Stevie Nicks. The ride earned him first place and \$1,760 and put him in the driver's seat to qualify for one of the two semifinals of the FWSSR's new tournament format.

"I was really excited to join the 90-point club," Howlett said. "It's my first time to be 90 and its great to do it here in this new arena."

The Fort Worth rodeo moved to a new home, Dickies Arena, in 2020 after nearly 70 years at Will Rogers Coliseum.

A pair of bull riders joined Howlett in the FWSSR 90-point club. Jordan Hansen of Ponoka, Alberta, scored 91 on Rafter G Rodeo's bull King Herod to win the event with Brady Portenier of Caldwell, Idaho, racking up 90 points on another Rafter G bull named Market Garden.

Samantha Jorgenson of Watford City, North Dakota, lowered the Dickies Arena record in breakaway roping to 2.1 seconds and won the round.

The same group of cowboys and cowgirls compete a second time Sunday afternoon at 2 p.m. to determine who will move on to the semifinals and wild card rounds.
