SPRINGTACULAR REGULATIONS

Entry Rules

- All Jackpot Show Exhibitors must be 8 to 19 years of age as of January 1, 2019.
- Entry Fees: Fees are per animal per show:
 - \$15.00 for Goats, Hogs and Lambs
 - \$30.00 for Beef (Market and Breeding)
 - \$15.00 for Showmanship (Limit of one entry per species per show)
- All Entries and entry fees shall be made online at, www.fremontcountyfair.org/spring_fair before Tuesday, June 4, 2019 at 6 p.m. Please be sure to print out a confirmation of entry, upon completion of entering.
- **Late Entry: A late processing fee of \$20.00 per exhibitor will apply after 6 p.m. on June 4.**
Late Entry: Late Entry forms will be accepted, by mail, postmarked June 5 and after, with a late processing fee of \$20.00 per exhibitor. On site entries may be taken before species weigh in only, on Saturday; all on site entries will be charged an additional late fee of \$10.00 per head. No entries will be accepted after the final weigh in time, by species, on Saturday. No phone entries will be accepted at any time.
- Entry forms will be provided for those unable to enter online with an additional \$10 processing fee and are due at the Fair Office by Monday, June 3, 2019 at 6 p.m.
- Entry Forms must be signed by the participant and the parent(s) or guardian, if under 19 years old. Entry Forms not properly completed and signed will not be accepted.
- **NO REFUNDS WILL BE PROVIDED after the June 4 entry deadline.**
- **No animals on grounds prior to 3:00 p.m. Friday, June 7!** Springtacular exhibitors with animals on grounds in pen/stalls prior to 3:00 p.m. will be assessed a fee of \$50 per exhibitor, which must be paid prior to being accepted as an exhibitor. .
- All animals must be weighed on Saturday, June 8 to show. **Absolutely no off-loading of any animals after the close of weigh-ins on Saturday, June 8.**
- For 2019 there will only be one showmanship contest per species. Showmanship will be divided into three age groups: as of 01/01/19; Junior 8-12, Intermediate 13-15, Senior 16-19.
- Exhibitors must use their own animal for showmanship classes. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor showing. Family owned animals cannot be shown.

Animal Health Rules

- All animals must conform to current State of Wyoming animal health and brand requirements.
- Please note the current State of Wyoming import regulations regarding swine in the online Springtacular documents.
- All animals must have a current (within 7 days of arrival) Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and will be inspected prior to off-loading! **Note:** There will be NO complimentary inspection and NO complimentary certificates written. Any animal showing symptoms of a contagious or infectious disease may not be allowed to unload or may be removed from the premises at the discretion of the Springtacular Management or their designated representative. Any lamb exhibiting an active stage of show lamb fungus or ringworm will not be allowed to unload or will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds.

Classification Rules

- All market beef cattle will be weighed; all market goats, hogs and lambs will be weighed.
- Goats and lambs must have been slick shorn within the prior week, with no patterns. Goats and lambs must have their baby teeth in place.
- All animals will be sorted by a committee at the scales during weigh-in to determine proper classification.
- Springtacular management reserves the right to combine or divide classes as needed.

Exhibitor Policy and Procedures

- The current Wyoming State Fair Youth Livestock Show Policies and Procedures will be followed in general and by species. These guidelines include the National Code of Show Ring Ethics and the Wyoming State Fair Foreign Substance Prevention and Residue Avoidance Program.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages by guests and exhibitors is prohibited at all times at Fairplex during the Springtacular activity schedule.

Premium Payout

- Each entry fee will have \$5.00 per entry withheld for awards support and processing fee. Showmanship entry fee will have \$5.00 per exhibitor withheld as an office processing fee.
- Entry Fees, less office processing fees, will be used for class premiums, for the jackpot format.
- Class premiums will be based on the number of animals shown in class with predetermined percentages and places paid, set as shown:

7 or more shown =	35%	25%	20%	15%	05%
6 or less shown =	40%	30%	20%	10%	

- Showmanship premiums will be paid out with five (5) cash payouts per exhibitor age division and by species shown. Premium payout based on five places with predetermined percentages as set with class premiums.
- Class and Championship premiums will be paid in cash; premiums will be paid by cash on Saturday, June 8 (3pm until 7 pm) and on Sunday, June 9 (11 am until 4 pm). Exhibitors must pick up cash premiums prior to departure on Sunday, as no premiums under \$75.00 will be mailed. Exhibitors are **fully responsible** for premiums being picked up at the designated times.

Exhibitor Notices

- Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own bedding.
- Wood chips for bedding will be provided for first bedding by show management upon arrival.
- Exhibitors are to clean out pens or stalls before leaving the show.
- Campground space for campers/trailers with electrical, sewer and water hookups are available for \$30.00 per day/night. Full hook up space is based on first request, first served, so please contact the fair office with your request for space by June 4.
- Concessions will be available near the show area for exhibitor convenience. Concessions provided by Friends of Fremont County Fair, a Springtacular Major Sponsor.
- All trailers are to be parked in the gravel lot to the west of the campground. No trailers are to be parked in any other location within the show barn area.
- No parking of vehicles, at any time, on the North or South sides of all show barns and the campground.

Rule Enforcement

- **THE FREMONT COUNTY SPRINGTACULAR MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE FINAL AND ABSOLUTE RIGHT TO INTERPRET THESE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND THEIR DECISION WILL BE FINAL.**

- Each report of rule violations will be reviewed by the Show Management and appropriate action will be taken. If the matter is not resolved to your satisfaction you may file a protest. Instructions for "Protests" are available at the Fair Office.

2019 SPRINGTACULAR JACKPOT SHOW RULES

- **All Animal Entries:**
 - Animal Health Papers (CVI current: within 7 days required for each animal) required with inspection offsite, prior to arriving on grounds, at SE: Gate 3.(off of South 8th Street)
- **Hog Show Rules:**
 - Classes determined after weigh in
 - All breeds/crosses and genders will be shown together on Saturday; by gender on Sunday.
 - Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health and/or quality.
- **Goat Show Rules:**
 - Classes determined after weigh in
 - All breeds/crosses and genders will be shown together
 - Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health and/or quality.
- **Lamb Show Rules**
 - Classes determined after weigh in
 - All breeds/crosses and genders will be shown together
 - Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health and/or quality.
- **Beef Cattle Show Rules:**
 - **Market Beef:**
 - Classes determined after weigh in

- All breeds/crosses and genders will be shown together
- Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health and/or quality.

□ Breeding Beef:

- English Breeds: Purebreds only, for Angus (Black and Red), Hereford, Galloway and Shorthorn. Purebred verification required.
- Continental/Crosses: All other breeds and all crosses entered in this division
- Commercial Heifer class (non-registered/non purebred heifers) need breed sire and dam listed on entry form.
- Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries if animal is of questionable health and/or quality.

Showmanship Rules:

- Entry Fee \$15 per exhibitor; one entry per species. \$10 used for jackpot payout for top five (5) places in each age division.
- Animal and exhibitor must compete together in class, to be eligible for showmanship
- **All exhibitors must show their own animals.**
- Beef cattle, goat, lamb and swine showmanship age divisions will be broken as follows: Junior (8-12), Intermediate (13-15), Senior (16-19). Based on exhibitor numbers entered, heats may be used with no additional payout.
