- The general entrance is located off of Kings Canyon Avenue, just East of the normal Kings Canyon pedestrian gate and before you reach the Infield Parking entrance.
- The Fast Pass entrance is off of Kings Canyon Avenue, just West of the normal Kings Canyon pedestrian gate
- The entrance for those attendees who pre-registered for their free COVID-19 testing is off of Kings Canyon Avenue, just West of the normal Kings Canyon pedestrian gate.
