- Tamales must be delivered BEFORE 11 a.m. hot and ready to eat.
- Volunteers will be on hand for check-in.
- Best Homemade Tamale winner will be announced at 3 p.m. on October 8.
  
- A minimum of one (1) ingredient used must be showcased in our Agriculture Building and/or grown in Fresno County.
- This competition is to showcase the flavors of our Central Valley.
- Tamales must be from an original recipe. Each recipe must be homemade, named, original, unpublished, and the sole property of the entrant.

Categories for judging will be:

- Best Meat – meat classes will be broken into specific classes upon delivery.
- Best No Meat/Vegetarian
- Best Sweet/Dessert
