The 52nd Annual Woodsmen's Field Day Event will be held on Monday, September 30. Hope you all will be joining us this year. The Official Handbook can be found on the Fryeburg Fair website. All results are final at the end of the show. Any concerns must be expressed during the show. Only official time sheets will be used. NO videos, pictures, etc. will be considered. Stats and times must be reviewed during the show and concerns expressed at that time. Results at the end of the show are final

CHANGES AND REMINDERS FOR 2019

- Sixteen to 18 years old can enter the Men's Events. Contestants under 18 must have parents or legal guardians permission on the A-B of the Waiver and Release from Liability Form. Do a biography new or update.
- Super Master's contestants must be 68 years or older at time of the event.
- Please remember to put the (BD) Birthdate on entry form.
- Please sign and include the Insurance waiver.
- There will be 2 axe throw targets. Target A will be the Men Group Target B will be Masters, Super Masters and Women. **Check the rule book for the the new rules for the Axe Throw Contest.**
- Log roll...Log will be 135 BF + 16 ft. log.
- 10X10 timbers will be used in all contests using timbers, except 8X8 to be used in the Women's and Super Masters; Underhand Chop and Standing Block Chop.
- Blocks will be given out near the track by a drawing done by the contestants.
- Trees will be drawn before the contest. There will be 20 trees. Should a tree not be used, the next drawn after 20 will be assigned to the next Woodsman.
- Passes will be sent by the end of August. This informs you that your registration has been received. Hats only to be given out to contestants.
- Because of the number of contestants and complexity, it is not possible to make changes on the day of the show except for cancellations. Changes must be made by contacting Elaine by September 23. This includes your partners for log roll and crosscuts.
