1. Eligibility
 - a. Junior Division: 4-H and FFA members from 4th to 9th grade. Grades defined as September 1 of current year.
 - b. Senior Division: 4-H and FFA members from 10th-12th grade, but can include members of 9th grade. Grades defined as September 1 of current year.
 - c. Collegiate Division: Open to all senior and junior colleges in the United States offering a degree or program in agriculture and/or animal science. Junior and senior college contestants will compete in same division. Junior and senior collegiate teams will be scored together.
2. Entry Fee:
 - a. Entries due September 20, 2018 to receive ground passes to enter the fairgrounds.
 - b. Contest entry fee is \$15.00 per competitor. Entries submitted on time will receive grounds passes to enter the Georgia National Fairgrounds.
 - c. Late entries will be \$25.00 per competitor and will NOT include ground passes.

3. You will need to enter the Livestock Gate to receive your grounds passes.
4. Junior and Senior 4-H/FFA Divisions will consist of a maximum of four (4) individuals per team with the top three (3) scores constituting the team score.
5. Collegiate Division will consist of five (5) individuals per team with the top four (4) scores constituting the team score. Alternates may compete for individual honors.
6. You will not be allowed to add contestants the day of the contest; however, you may substitute.
7. Junior/Senior 4-H/FFA Division:
 - a. Max of 10 placing classes including market and breeding beef, swine, sheep and goats
 - b. Juniors will give a minimum of one set of reasons.
 - c. Seniors will give a minimum of two sets of reasons.

8. Collegiate Division:
 - a. Max of 10 placing classes including market and breeding beef, swine, sheep and goats
 - b. 6 sets of reasons
9. Performance data will be provided on selected breeding classes
10. Awards will include team and individual results.
11. Contestants talking to anyone but a group leader may be disqualified. Personal communication devices are prohibited.
