- There is no limit to the number of entries in this category, but each image may only be submitted once.
- These photos will be incorporated into the "30 Years of Fair Memories" photo display in the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building.
- Photos can be submitted between 12:00 AM and 11:59 PM each day. Photos submitted after 11:59 PM will be considered for the following day. Photos for October 13 must be submitted by 11:59 PM to be considered.
- The best fair photo from each day of the fair will win a blue ribbon.
- Winner of "Best Fair Photo" will be chosen from the daily blue ribbon winners and will receive \$50 and a special rosette.
