- Exhibitor or team of exhibitors will create a photo opportunity cutout.
- This cutout:
  - must be an original design
  - must be the work of the exhibitor and cannot be professionally printed
  - must have at least one face opening, but may have more than one
  - must be functional - People must be able to access it to take their picture.
  - must be made of plywood or a comparable sturdy material
  - must be freestanding and not present a trip hazard
  - must be stable and durable enough to withstand use through the fair
  - must reflect a "fair" theme and contain some recognizable element of the fair - rides, food, animals, competitions, etc.
  - may be designed for children, adults, or a combination
- A sketch of the design must be submitted for approval by September 18, 2019. Email images to [contests@gnfa.com](mailto:contests@gnfa.com).
- The Georgia National Fair reserves the right to reject any exhibit offered if it is objectionable in any way. For these purposes, the definition of “objectionable” includes, but is not limited to: representations of nudity, graphic violence, profanity, or any depictions of a sexually explicit nature. Decisions of the Georgia National Fair will be final.
- Photo op entries will be displayed outside around the fairgrounds for the duration of the fair.
