PRICE SUPPORTS:

If you would like to contribute to support the entire auction, a species, or club you may do so by issuing a check payable to "Nor Cal Youth Livestock Association." (a private 501(c)3) before or during the auction. Please indicate who you would like to support in the memo line of the check and mail it to P.O. Box 353, Orland, CA 95963, prior to the sale or bring it ringside on sale day. After the results of the sale are tabulated, exhibitors receiving considerably lower prices may receive a support check to help with their expenses.

STOCKMAN AWARDS:

The stockman awards are an opportunity to acknowledge the exhibitor for a job well done. Nominate them for an individual award (will not exceed \$500 per nomination). Awards are made if youth meet criteria and if funding is available and are issued in a separate check after the event. Please see Nor Cal Youth Livestock Brochure for nomination forms and payment details.

ADD ON POLICY

The Glenn County Fair Junior Livestock Auction will accept exhibitor add ons prior to the fair and until 2 hours after sale completion. Add ons will be accepted at a minimum of \$500, no maximum. The 7% commission will apply to all add ons. The add on checks will be distributed out of the fair office the week after fair.

No exhibitors, or voting member of the Junior Livestock Committee can substitute an animal after the sale, nor can they purchase an animal from an auction buyer which the buyer has designated for resale or slaughter. The buyer must have originally designated at the sale time that the animal was to be "picked up live." Any resale of "picked up live" animals must take place after the animal has been removed from the fairgrounds.

JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION INFORMATION:

After many months of planning and hard work, the 2019 Glenn County Fair Junior Livestock is at hand.

The animals presented for sale to the community have had many hours of intense work and a considerable amount of money invested in them by Glenn County 4-H, FFA, and Independent Youth exhibitors. Beginning with the beef projects, which were purchased last fall, up to the more recently purchased small animals such as poultry and rabbits, these animals have had lavish attention and the best care possible.

Many of our youth support breeding projects within their market project and also show at other livestock shows such as Jr. Grand National and specialty breed shows. Exhibitors have attended many training meetings, learning activities and have signed a code of conduct in order to participate in the Glenn County Fair Junior Livestock Auction.

There are many ways to show support for the Glenn County youth involved in market animal projects. One of the best ways you can show your support is to be a bidder and a buyer at the Junior Livestock Auction. Examples of how you can buy at the auction are listed in the next columns.



OUTRIGHT BUYERS:

You bid a price (usually per lb.) on the animal of your choice against other bidders. The bid amount accepted is the amount the bidder pays to Tri-Counties Bank. Harvest fees will be collected at time of purchase and the buyer must pay all cutting and wrapping charges directly to your processor.

RESALE BUYERS:

You bid a price on the animal of your choice against other bidders. The bid amount accepted by the auctioneer is the sale price. The buyer consigns the animal back to the Glenn County Fair for resale and only pays the difference between the bid amount and the current market price posted at the ring on the day of the sale. There are no process, cut or wrap charges. The buyer does not keep the animal.

MULTIPLE BUYERS PER ANIMAL:

Two or more individuals decide to buy an animal together. One person acts as the "responsible party" and bids on the animal of their choice against other bidders. The bid amount accepted by the auctioneer (plus process, cut and wrap charges) is then split between all the multiple buyers as decided amongst themselves. The "responsible party" is the buyer for contract purposes and payment collection.



PARTICIPATION IN A BUYER'S GROUP:

If you would like to contribute a flat amount to be pooled with other participants in a buyers' group, please contact one of the individuals listed on the back of this brochure. The groups purchase "no bid" animals and proceeds left may be used for price supports.

DISPOSITION OF ANIMALS

There are many different choices available for disposition of animals. After sale agreement has been signed disposition of animal may not be changed.

PROCESS:

All animals will be slaughtered at USDA inspected facilities or may be picked up live and slaughtered at your ranch. The animal is butchered and processed according to the buyer's instructions with the processor of their choice. You may also make arrangements to donate your animal to your favorite charitable organization The buyer will be responsible for all processing charges.

RESALE:

The animal is consigned back to the Fair for resale.

LIVE PICKUP:

The buyer may choose to pick up an animal live at the conclusion of the Jr. Livestock Auction, upon proof of payment from close of sale until 10:00PM that night; or, at the time of release of all other livestock after 7:00PM on Sunday, May 19, 2019. Signed release form must be presented in order to exit the fairgrounds.
