## Parade Rules

1. Theme for 2019 is: "Let the Good Times GROW!"
2. Any person or group may enter the Glenn County Fair Parade.
3. Drivers must possess a valid driver's license, and proof of insurance at entry close.
4. Units with sound or unusual noises must be indicated on the entry form.
5. No alcohol consumption allowed on the parade route.
6. **You are asked to check-in and pick up your line-up number between 4:00 P.M. - 5:30 P.M on Friday May 17, 2019 at the staging area check in (to be announced).** Only one member of each group is necessary to check-in and pick up the placement entry number.
7. Parade officials will be available to direct you to your place in the line-up on Friday.
8. Parade begins at 6:00 P.M. SHARP. Units not checked in by 5:30 P.M. will be placed at the end of the parade line.
9. **Entry numbers are to be placed on the DRIVER side** toward the front of your unit.
10. Keep in *forward motion* at all times. Failure to comply with rules may result in removal from the Parade.
11. No entries will be allowed to stop during the Parade.
12. Keep at least two car lengths between units. Please follow instructions given by the parade officials.
13. All participants must stay within the boundaries of the parade route. Anyone leaving the route will not be re-admitted.
14. All units must complete the parade route.
15. Throwing objects from your unit, **INCLUDING CANDY** on the parade is strictly forbidden. You may have people walk beside your unit and hand out candy or trinkets or flyers.
16. Entries must always have full control of animals or vehicles.
17. Marching and Drill Team Units are asked not to stop and perform in front of the Judges.
18. Judging Stand is at Library Park (4th & Yolo Streets).
19. All float and parade entries with children riding on the float will receive FREE ENTRY into the Fair on Friday 5/17/19.
20. The Parade Committee reserves the right to reject any entry not considered safe.
