Ear Tagging

All animals must be tagged by the ownership deadline (120 days for beef, 60 days for hogs, lambs & goats, 30 days for rabbits, poultry and turkeys). Tags may be picked up in the fair office.

Online Entries

All exhibitors are required to complete entries online by April 16th.

Ethics Training

All Fair exhibitors are required to complete the YQCA online training by April 16th. Please visit www.yqca.org to complete.
