**4. Old Business:**

CEO Newman stated that the labor expense for the installation of the lights in the barns came in under budget. The \$800.00 fee will be reimbursed to the fair.

**5. Financial Report:**

The current balance of the JLA account is \$42,906.39 This was accepted by a motion made by Diane Amaro and seconded by Christina Ward.

**6. Adult showmanship fundraiser for JLC:**

An adult showmanship class was proposed. It will be held on Wednesday night at seven or after the swine show in Brawley arena. The class is a "for fun" fund raiser for the JLC. The proceeds will go towards improvements in the barn area. Dane Nissen and other JLC staff will help implement the class. The nominations will be accepted in the livestock office on Wednesday. Costumes are encouraged. It was determined that there would be no alcohol allowed in the arena. Each exhibitor would arrange their own hog. The award will be recognition on a plaque.

**7. Willows Honker Goat Project / auction schedule and choreography:**

It was suggested that the project should be explained prior to the beginning of the sale. The kids will be accompanied by their mentors. They will sell wherever they are placed in the sale order. The JLC will see how the music goes for each species champion drive and then try to recreate it for the sale of champions.

**8. Music for Champion drives:**

Each species will try to acknowledge the prestige of their champion drive by playing motivational music. JLC members would bring a Bose speaker to create the music.

**9. Buyers gifts:**

Christina Ward purchased 500 buyer's hats. Tri Counties will be sponsoring the hats but the additional embroidery will exceed the \$3,000. Sponsorship and the JLC will be supplementing

**10. List of things to remember at fair timer:**

Better PA for exhibitor show, more flags and clip boards for the auction, pygmy goat class needs to be broke into two classes.

**11. Decide On species caps during fair:**

CEO Newman reminded the JLC that the fair barns are close to capacity and that the members need to be aware of the challenges the fair is having in accommodating all of the exhibits. The committee will look at the issue and decide on a course of action for the future.
