Orland, CA – The Glenn County Fair Board of Directors met last night for an emergency meeting regarding COVID-19 and its impact on the fairgrounds. As recommended by the CDC, State and Local Governments, the Board moved that all interim events at the fairgrounds are cancelled until May 10, 2020. The property and office will be closed to the public for the time being. The Glenn County Fairgrounds takes the health and safety of our community very seriously.
