

Glenn County Fair Event Protocols

- 1. Alcohol service will stop 1 hour prior to event end time.
- 2. Bands can play until 11:30 PM or 15 minutes prior to events conclusion.
- 3. Any outdoor event that has any form of sound amplification, is limited between the hours of 10AM and 10PM for any and all sound amplification.
- 4. Guests are allowed to go out the front doors to smoke, however smoking is not permitted within 20' of any door.
- 5. Guests are not permitted to spill out into other areas not being rented for their event. This includes kids running loose and not under parental supervision.
- 6. Guards must stay until all guests are gone. Clean up crew may be onsite when guards leave.
- 7. The 42nd DAA reserves the right to deny ticket sales and/or admission to the grounds to any individuals.
- 8. Anyone engaging in disruptive conduct including fighting, using/displaying offensive language or any other conduct disruptive to operations or patrols will result in eviction and/or arrest.
- 9. No outside alcohol may be brought onto the fairgrounds. The only alcoholic beverages permitted on the premises are those with prior written consent by the 42nd DAA. Alcohol must be consumed in designated areas. All other alcohol will be confiscated. Under no circumstance will alcohol be allowed to leave the grounds.
- 10. Selling, advertising or distributing products, services, or printed material without the prior authorization by the 42nd DAA is prohibited.
- 11. No firearms or weapons of any nature whatsoever may be brought onto the fairgrounds without prior authorization of the 42nd DAA or its lessee including any model firearms, airsoft, or paintball guns.
- 12. No pets or other animals are permitted except guide dogs, service dogs, or signal dogs, as defined in Civil Code section 54, or with prior authorization of the 42nd DAA or its lessee.
- 13. The use of bikes, skateboards, roller skates etc. is prohibited without prior authorization of the 42nd DAA.
- 14. Traffic and parking laws are strictly enforced. Improperly parked vehicles will be towed at owners expense.
- 15. All vehicles must comply with the posted speed limit of 5mph.
- 16. All vehicles entering the grounds must comply with the direction and instruction of security/parking staff. Any violation of this rule may result in the towing of the vehicle and occupants subject to arrest for violation of the Penal Code section 602 (trespassing)/
- 17. No unauthorized overnight parking.
