The Gonzales Economic Development Corporation, by this instrument, notifies the public of a **PUBLIC HEARING March 23, 2015** on the following projects that were approved by the GEDC Board at the February 23, 2015 Regular Meeting:

- 1. Donald Rihn's SBIG application for 521 St. Joseph was approved, with a 1 year term on the performance agreement, for 50% of \$7500.00 project to make improvements to the doors and windows. He has a 1 year lease with Robert & Laurie Nesloney who will bring the second location of "Laurie's Boutique & Tanning" to downtown Gonzales.**
- 2. Chris Kappmeyer's SBIG application for The Gonzales Mansion/Venue was approved for 50% of \$24,901.96 for improvements to the building and grounds, and purchase of tables & chairs to be used for events at the Venue.**

The GEDC will hold a **Public Hearing MARCH 23, 2015, at the Gonzales City Hall, 820 St. Joseph St., during the Regular Meeting that begins at 6:00pm,** to allow for public comment on these projects and the proposed expenditure of 4B Sales Tax funds.

The funding expenditure for these projects were approved by City Council at the March 3, 2015 meeting.

The GEDC encourages citizens to participate in the public comment and public hearing stages of all GEDC projects.
