PASSES FOR 4-H AND FFA MEMBERS AND LEADERS AND/OR ADVISORS.

Only enrolled 4-H Club Leaders and FFA Chapter Advisors will be permitted to purchase passes for their enrolled members and leaders/advisors. Those persons not enrolled as members or leaders/advisors but needed by the club/chapter may be eligible to purchase a Season Worker Pass for \$13.00. Forms for 4-H/FFA passes will be provided to all 4-H clubs and FFA chapters. 4-H parents, guardians, or other adults assisting the 4-H members may be eligible to purchase either Daily Worker/Parent Passes for \$3.00/pass or Season Worker/Parent Passes for \$13.00/pass. **THERE WILL BE A LIMIT OF 2 SEASON WORKER/PARENT PASSES PER ENROLLED MEMBER, OR IF PURCHASING DAILY WORKER/PARENT PASSES IN LUE OF SEASON PASSES, A LIMIT OF TWO PASSES PER DAY WILL BE ALLOWED.** Worker/Parent Passes are not intended for general use by the public, relatives, or other fair attendees; they are for the responsible adult escorting an enrolled member only. The Fairgrounds Management reserves the right to limit passes sold, and to determine qualifying criteria. Misuse or misrepresentation of qualifying criteria for the purchase of discounted Exhibitor and Worker/Parent Passes may result in denial of entry, revocation/no issuance of passes, and/or ineligibility for future passes to be purchased. **The deadline for groups purchasing passes is July 12, 2019. The Fairgrounds Management reserves the right to limit the number of discount passes sold, and to determine eligibility criteria for discount passes.**

ALL PASSES MUST BE PURCHASED PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FAIR. *Absolutely no passes will be sold after 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 6th, 2019.*

PARKING: No parking will be allowed in areas other than designated parking lots. Overnight parking will be allowed only in designated areas. All trailers, including livestock and horse trailers, are to park in assigned areas only. **Exhibitor's trailers left in the general parking lot may forfeit their premium points. Vehicles parked in undesignated places may be towed at owner's expense.**

DELIVERIES: Deliveries should come through the Service Gate located on Fairgrounds Road. The fairgrounds will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. for delivery inside the grounds. All vehicles must be removed by 9:30 a.m. If a delivery must be made after 9:30 a.m. vehicles will stop at the Service Gate and make arrangements to move supplies onto the fairgrounds.

CASH MACHINE: There are two cash machines on the grounds, one is located in the Pavilion and one is located at the Front Ticket Booth, for the duration of the fair.

CHECK CASHING: The fair office and information booth will not cash checks. Commercial banks are located within one mile of the fairgrounds.

CONCERT SHOW ADMISSION: Concerts are free with fair admission. Limited reserved Golden Circle Seating, which are the first ten rows, are available at a cost for some major concerts.
