2019 Position Overview

Outriders will support event promotions including community engagement, special events, and rodeo activities to support the Greeley Stampede objectives and goals. They will also serve as event ambassadors at community networking events and assist with VIP guests during the event.

Essential Job Functions

- Represent and promote the Greeley Stampede at community networking events including
 Chamber Business Before Hours, Chamber Business After Hours and Young Professional events
- Support special event promotions including the Kickoff Lunch, Kickoff Concert, hosted Chamber events, trade show booths, community parades and the Big Buckle Ball
- Support sponsor promotions including rodeo promotions, onsite engagement, rodeo contestant bags, and rodeo day sheets
- Support event promotions including stick horse rodeos, behind the chutes tours, media day, daily parade in the park, sheep stampede, Cowboy Games, Touch-a-Truck, and Brushes & Bulls
- Support the mascot program and help coordinate appearances
- Represent the Greeley Stampede by hosting event VIPs during the event as needed
- Represent the Greeley Stampede by delivering hospitality packages as needed
- Support the marketing campaign by assisting with the distribution of marketing materials including brochures, posters and yard signs
- Support general office duties including document filing, paper shredding and mailing

- Oral and written communications skills including public speaking
- Organizational and interpersonal skills
